<b>Phase 1</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Community of Practice for adult education, training, and other related providers is established</li> <li>• Full AJC partner integration</li> <li>• Begin One-Stop operator solicitation process</li> <li>• Expand earn-and-learn opportunities, OJTs, Apprenticeships</li> <li>• Ensure workforce development and outreach documents are translated into relevant languages</li> <li>• Ensure programmatic and physical accessibility of all services at AJCs to individuals with disabilities</li> <li>• Expansion of the Data Vault</li> <li>• Develop Vendor Scorecards</li> <li>• Creation of the common data dictionary and methods for measurement</li> <li>• Increase enrollment of Out-of-School Youth in WIOA Youth Programming</li> <li>• Planning for a developmentally appropriate youth one-stop</li> </ul>
<b>Phase 2</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• OSSE AFE grant competition funds innovative models for integrated education and training</li> <li>• Integrated Service Delivery in AJCs</li> <li>• One-Stop operator is selected and in place</li> <li>• Expanded functionality of the Data Vault</li> <li>• One-Stop MOUs in place</li> <li>• Expand business advisory committees to include all identified high-demand sectors</li> <li>• Unified business services strategy established and implementation steps started</li> <li>• Youth one-stop model finalized.</li> <li>• Ensure the availability of pre-employment transition services for all students with disabilities</li> <li>• Coordination between DOES, OSSE, DCPS and relevant DC Public Charter schools to ensure work experiences are aligned with a student's CTE program of study</li> </ul>
<b>Phase 3</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Business advisory committees leveraged to inform training investments in all high-demand sectors</li> <li>• Streamlined communication tools and inter-agency operating procedures</li> <li>• Continue expansion and modifications based on user feedback of the Data Vault partners</li> <li>• Develop shared case management across core programs</li> <li>• Increase capacity of education and training providers through Career Pathways funded initiatives.</li> <li>• Ensure performance data from core program providers and sub grantees is available and accessible to the public through the Dashboard</li> <li>• Youth one-stop established and serving youth.</li> </ul>
